Unite the civil society around an open and participative project

- 2030.lu is an initiative whose aim is to address:
 - the future of Luxembourg
 - the challenges faced by our country
- 2030.lu takes the form of a broad public debate. It is an open debate:
 - everybody can join, participate and speak up
 - each participant decides on his/her level of implication

The what and how of "2030.lu – Ambition for the future"

Do not close your eyes on the country's future. And first and foremost: speak up and help prepare the future!

- 2030.lu wants
 - to reunite a large number of people
 - that wish to engage in a discussion about the future of our country
- 2030.lu offers
 - interested participants an interactive an novel platform...
 - to discuss,
 - to debate and
 - to contribute

in shaping a strategic vision for Luxembourg

Who "owns" "2030.lu – Ambition for the future" ? (1)

- 2030.lu is an initiative enabling the civil society to express itself and to discuss policy proposals and actions
- 2030.lu has the sole ambition to depict a vision for the country. 2030.lu is not the ownership of an organisation, but is "owned" by the civil society at large
- ➔ 2030.lu puts ideas at the centre of its action
- ➔ 2030.lu is not owned by the people offering the platform, but by those who make the platform

Who "owns" "2030.lu – Ambition for the future" ? (2)

- 2030.lu enjoys the active support and participation of people representing all viewpoints and schools of thought
- Participants should be single individuals and not act as representatives of organisations
- 2030.lu enjoys the physical support of the Chamber of Commerce of the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg
- 2030.lu is a unique and novel initiative. It aims to kick-start an inclusive discussion about the future of Luxembourg

What are the necessary steps to get things going?

- In 2012, numerous interviews with economic and social leaders, with trade unionists, students, academics and NGO leaders took place
- They enabled us to identify the main priorities for Luxembourg
- Working groups have contributed to this momentum as well
- The relevance of these insights has been corroborated by a representative opinion poll

Time has now come to move to a second stage.

Thus 2030.lu has emerged as an open and participative platform for debate

To wrap up...

- 2030.lu is an initiative with the aim to gather as many stakeholders as possible in order to...
- ... reach a consensus on the major challenges faced by Luxembourg in the future:
 - Raise awareness for the challenges faced by the country among the public at large
 - Depart from traditional stakes and break the *status quo*

 ... spark and stir public debate about the future paths the country should follow, by

- Developing a vision of what a "better future" means for Luxembourg
- Encouraging policy-makers, economic actors and civil society stakeholders to enter the debate and to position themselves in that debate.

The objective: maintain our quality of life

- The key ingredients are as follows:
 - a sustained high and fair distribution of standard of living
 - a diversified economic fabric
 - a proper social cohesion
 - an inclusive education system
 - a fair and well-managed social security system
 - an environmentally sustainable way of living and working
 - a financially sound and politically independent country


